

### **Chefs Uniform Requirements:**

- Chefs white skull cap,
- White necktie
- Jacket: white double breasted with white buttons. Chef/ Cookery students are required to wear LONG sleeve jackets. I recommend that when you buy buttons you buy an extra set as these can sometimes get lost. Remove when washing as the buttons can become weak in the wash and break.
- Apron - white, can be a bib front apron or worn from the hips.
- Chef Pants - blue (back) and white chequered chef trousers OR black chef trousers.
- Shoes: Leather, no laces, closed in shoes OR chef clogs
- **NO** funky uniforms, chef jackets or pants are accepted.

### **Patisserie Students ONLY**

- Patisserie Jacket: white double breasted with white buttons. Patisserie students **ONLY** can wear SHORT sleeve patisserie jackets. I recommend that when you buy buttons you buy an extra set as these can sometimes get lost. Remove when washing as the buttons can become weak in the wash and break.
- Skull cap, necktie, apron, pants and shoes - as per chef requirements.

### **Chefs In Trade**

If you are already in-trade at the time of enrolment and your uniform differs from above,

- Most in-trade students have already spoken to their chef instructor regarding uniform at your induction meeting.
